

OD780: Four Dimensions of Leadership for Military Chaplaincy (4 units)

DESCRIPTION/RELEVANCE FOR MINISTRY:

This online course is foundational for the Military Chaplain D.Min. program. This course may be taken immediately upon admission to the program as an introduction to issues of personal development in leadership, spiritual leadership, team leadership and the unique context of leadership in the military. Biblical and Theological foundations for leadership will under gird a broader discussion of leadership practices in ministry.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Understand Biblical content /models of leadership.
- Understand and articulate a theology of leadership.
- Gain insight into personal leadership style.
- Gain appreciation for a variety of styles of leadership.
- Understand and apply learning of practical skills of team leadership and spiritual leadership in the Military Chaplaincy context.

COURSE FORMAT:

The class will be conducted on the Internet using a 10-week lesson program aligned with Fuller's academic calendar. Each week, students and the instructor will interact with the material and each other through journaling, threaded discussions, web-based research. Lectures for each lesson will be available online.
