NE534: Ephesians

For students who want to read ahead in Spring Quarter assignments, we list the first two weeks of required reading for NE534: Ephesians:

Week 1:

- At least glance over the relevant sections Perkins's commentary for the assigned portions from Ephesians, consulting her remarks especially where you find yourself puzzled about something in the Ephesians text.
- **Read** Best's first "Detached Note" (pp. 12-13). Then do the same in his commentary section as was just recommended for Perkins.
- **Read** the articles by Arnold ("Ephesians, Letter to") and Maile in the *Dictionary of Paul and his Letters*, pp. 238-249 and 381-383, respectively
- **Begin reading** the novel by Paton and the little book by Paillard, continuing in them as the quarter progresses.

Week 2:

- Read Best's "Introduction," pp. xxv-xxxiii, as well as his second "Detached Note" (pp. 32-33).
- **Consult** Perkins and Best as needed, keeping your eye on them as you work through the assigned text in Ephesians.
- Read Lincoln, pp. 75-102.
- **Read** the assigned articles by Arnold ("Ephesus") and Martin in *Dictionary of Paul and his Letters*, pp. 249-253 and 223-225, respectively.
